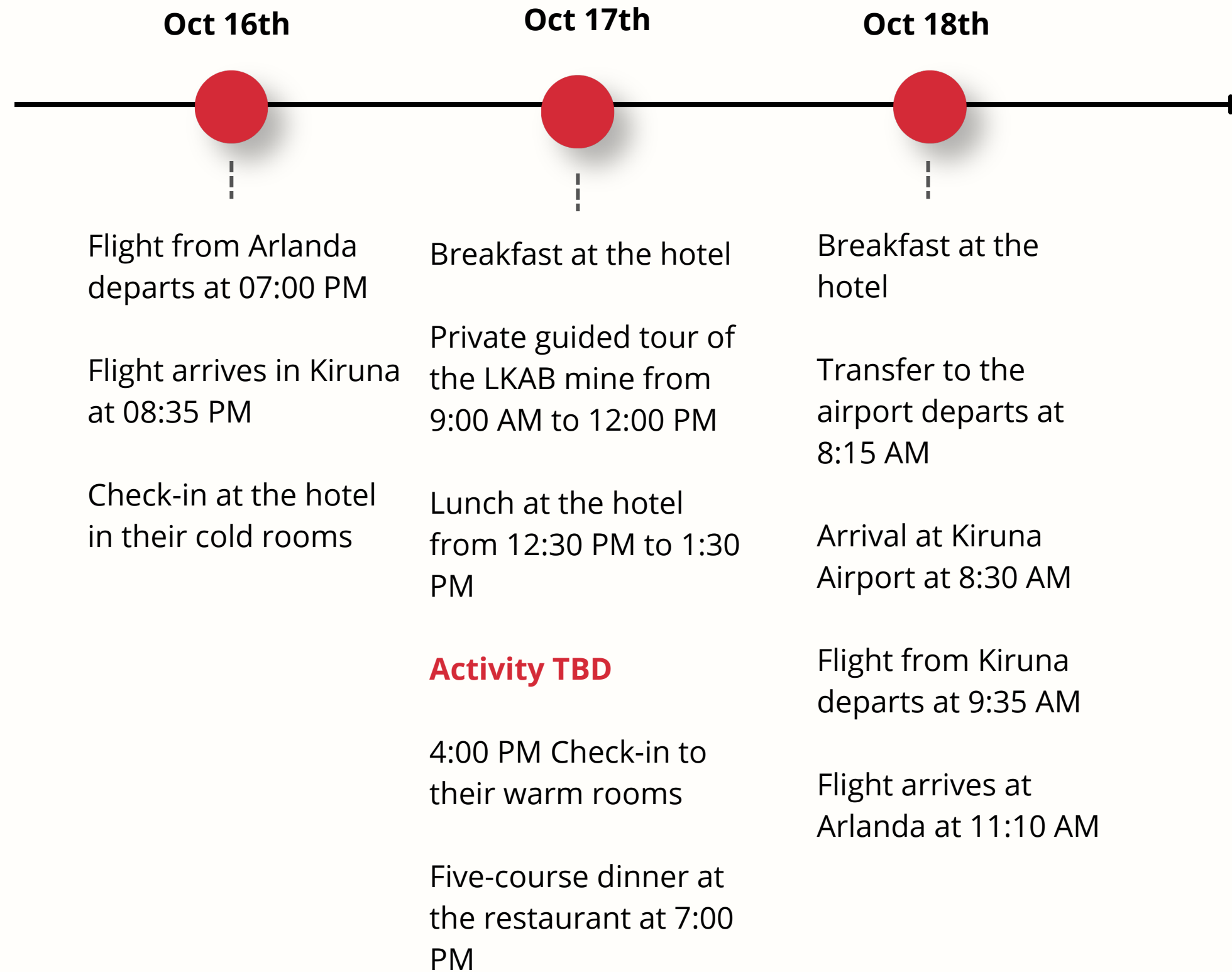

# ICEHOTEL Jukkasjärvi

ICEHOTEL is one of Sweden's most unique hotel experiences and is located in the small village of Jukkasjärvi, far north of the Arctic Circle in Swedish Lapland. The hotel is world-famous for its rooms built from ice and snow from the Torne River, where each suite and detail is created as a work of art. The surroundings are defined by Arctic nature, stillness and the unique light and landscapes that make this part of northern Sweden unforgettable year-round.

The stay combines both comfort and adventure by including one night in a warm hotel room and one night in the hotel's cold ice rooms. The warm night offers a chance to settle in, enjoy the environment, and experience the destination at a relaxed pace. The night in the cold room becomes a truly unique experience, where guests sleep surrounded by snow and ice in specially designed sleeping bags, in an environment that stays several degrees below zero all year round. Despite the cold, the experience is often described as both peaceful and unexpectedly comfortable.

During the stay, guests experience the contrast between modernity and nature, between warmth and cold, and between design hotel and wilderness. The combination of the two nights allows for a complete experience in a way that feels both exclusive and memorable.

# LKAB Mine – Private Guided Tour



A guided tour at the LKAB Visitor Centre offers a unique insight into one of the world's largest underground mines and the operations that have shaped the entire Kiruna region. During the visit, participants learn more about how the mine operates today, while the tour also provides an understanding of the mine's history and its importance to the region.

The tour also focuses on LKAB's future initiatives and its ambition to become one of the world's first fossil-free mining operations, offering an inspiring perspective on innovation, sustainability, and the industry of the future. Participants gain insight into how the company is working with the green transition and the impact the mine has both locally and globally.



Part of the experience also highlights the extensive urban transformation in Kiruna, where parts of the city are being relocated due to the expansion of the mine. The visit additionally provides insight into the logistics of iron ore transportation between Kiruna, Narvik, and Luleå. An essential part of the infrastructure that keeps the mining operations running.

The experience includes guidance from an experienced guide as well as necessary safety equipment. It is an experience that combines industrial history, sustainability efforts, and the unique development of Kiruna as both a city and a destination.
